	<p>TIMING CHIPS</p> <p>All riders will be timed by the chip on the back of their race plate.</p> <p>Do not bend plate when attaching it to your bike as it may damage or interfere with the timing chip. Do not cut, fold or alter your handlebar number plate where your printed number is not visible.</p> <p>Live Timing Results will be available Here as riders check-in their stage results.</p>
	<p>ENTRY FEE - \$120 (Before September 17th, 2018) On Site Fee - \$140</p> <p>INCLUDES: Race Entry, Day of Race(Sunday) Lift Access, Event T-Shirt</p> <p>ADDITIONS: Practice Lift Tickets may be purchased for Friday/Saturday - \$25 each. Practice Tickets can be pre purchased on the registration website or on site.</p>
	<p>CANCELLATION POLICY</p> <p>Unfortunately, we can't offer refunds on race registrations. You can, however, find someone who'd like to purchase your entry and transfer your registration to them. 	<p>WAIVERS</p> <p>All competitors must sign an event waiver/release of liability to compete.</p> <p>Race plates cannot be issued unless there is a properly completed waiver.</p> <p>If you are younger than 17 years of younger, you will need a parent or legal guardian to complete your waiver. Minors traveling to the event unaccompanied should have their parent or legal guardian complete the waiver ahead of the event and send to: ccasey@mammothresorts.com</p>											
	<p>RACE LICENSE</p> <p>The Kamikaze Bike Games Enduro is not sanctioned by UCI/USA Cycling. Competitors will not require a UCI or USA Cycling license to compete; nor will they be covered by their UCI or USA Cycling insurance (if applicable) during training and competition.</p> <p>Only competitors holding an EMBA membership will be eligible for Enduro World Series qualifying points. Riders will need to have a membership prior to the Mammoth race in order to be eligible to collect EWS Global Ranking points. Points will not be assigned retroactively if riders purchase the membership after the race. Riders can purchase / renew their 2018 EMBA/EWS memberships by clicking here.</p>

	<p>COURSE</p> <p>Pro and Expert Categories will race 5 stages (Stage 1-5) Sport and Beg Categories will race 4 stages (Stage 1-4)</p>											
<p>ENDURANCE DIFFICULTY</p>		<p>Racers can expect long day on the bike with long transfer climbs and long stages with technical sections and pedaling sections - all at altitude.</p>										
<p>TECHNICAL DIFFICULTY</p>		<p>Racers can expect packed to loose, fast, flowy terrain – consisting of intermediate to pro level trails.</p>										

	<p>PRACTICE</p> <p><i>During practice, courses are open to the general public. Please be conscious and courteous.</i></p> <p>Practice lift tickets may be purchased in advance with registration or on-site for \$25. Practice lift tickets are valid on all lifts at Mammoth Mountain.</p> <p>Friday, September 21, 2018 - Practice, 9:00am-5:30pm</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stage One/Stage Three will be slightly altered to accommodate the Downhill Practice/Qualification Run. Follow on course signage/marshal directions. • Stage Four will be closed until 11:00am. <p>Saturday, September 22, 2018 - Practice, 9:00am-5:30pm</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stage One/Stage Three will be slightly altered to accommodate Downhill Race. Follow on course signage/marshal directions. • Stage Four will be closed after 1pm to accommodate MegaKami Practice/Race.
	<p>SHUTTLES AND LIFTS</p> <p>The event will utilize three chairs/gondolas. Canyon Express (Chair 16), Stump Alley Express (Chair 2), and the Panorama Gondola (Main Lodge). These chairs are open to the public, with the exception of Canyon Express (Chair 16) being closed to the public on Sunday, September 23rd. During practice hours, there will not be a preferential racer line. During the race on Sunday, please use the designated Racer Line.</p> <p>No shuttling will be allowed. This will result in disqualification.</p> <p>All Enduro competitors receive lift access for day of race day with the cost of the entry.</p> <p>Practice lift tickets may be purchased in advance with registration or on-site for \$25. Practice lift tickets are valid on all lifts at Mammoth Mountain.</p> <p>Spectators may only ride Panorama Gondola. Tickets are available for purchase at the rate of \$17 at registration only.</p>
	<p>PROTECTION RULES</p> <p>Full face helmets will be required by the CES for this race. Helmets must be worn at all times – if you don't want to climb in a full-face, either carry two helmets or use a helmet with a removable chin bar.</p>
	<p>RACE INFORMATION</p> <p>START ORDER/RACE SEQUENCE</p> <p>Pro/Expert will run this sequence: Stage 1-5 in that order. Pro/Expert will receive a window based upon category for the start of transfer one. For example (Male Pro 8:00am-8:05am).</p>

Sport/Beginner will run this sequence: 3-4-1-2. Sport/Beginner transfer will begin at the bottom of Stump Alley Express (Chair 2). From Main Lodge, access via Downtown Trail. Sport/Beginner will receive a window for the start of transfer three.

The start order will be posted by Saturday, September 22nd at 5:00pm available online, at the rider meeting, and via e-mail to pre-registered riders.

Race Progress

You will only receive a start window for your first transfer. After you begin your race, you must make forward progress. Riders will be staged by a commissar in the order in which they arrive at each start. Riders MUST begin racing in the order determined by the commissar in each start area.

Aid Stations

There will be aid stations at:

- Bottom of Stage 1 and 2 @ Canyon Lodge (Bathrooms/Water/Nutrition)
- Top of Chair 2 (Porta Pottie/Water)
- Bottom of Chair 2 (Porta Pottie/Water/Nutrition)

Existing Services/Water:

- Bottom of Panorama Gondola (Bathrooms/Water)
- Mid Station Panorama Gondola (Bathrooms/Water)
- Top of Panorama Gondola (Bathrooms/Water)
- Main Lodge (Bathrooms/Water/Nutrition)

Course Cutting

Course cutting or taking short cuts in order to gain an advantage is not allowed. Riders not following the designated route will be disqualified.

Bike Rules




The bike that you begin the race on is the bike that you will use for the entire event - you may make repairs, but you must use the same frame. Repairs to the wheels and suspension is allowed, but replacement must be cleared with the race organizers. All other repairs and replacements are available - but the course/race will not be held, if you miss your race windows you will DNF.






Race Progress


This Enduro event needs to keep moving/progressing without breaks and ghosts (30 sec start time, no rider) in timing. All riders are strongly encouraged to make continuous progress. Stopping for lunch, social visits or the like may prevent you from riding one or more of the final stages.

Shuttling

No shuttling will be allowed. This will result in disqualification.

	<p><i>Outside Assistance (During the Race)</i> Any competitor receiving outside assistance from a non-racer without prior agreement from the Chief of Race will be disqualified. This includes using a team staff/outside help to carry equipment around the course or perform repairs during the race.</p> <p><i>Exception:</i> During the transition between stages once racers are back to the Main Lodge Base Area are permitted to obtain technical/mechanical assistance.</p> <p><i>Altering the Course</i> Any participant altering the course will be disqualified.</p> <p><i>Practicing Outside of Designated Practice Times</i> Riding race stages outside of designated practice times is prohibited and will result in disqualification.</p>
	<p>CLAIMS AND PENALTIES</p> <p>Commissaires and Marshals will be situated along the course to monitor for any rule violations. Claims regarding the race must be put forth to the Chief of Race within 15 minutes of the race finish of the last rider.</p> <p>The Race Director is authorized to give additional penalties that are not listed in the CES rules in the case of a rider who fails to respect the other riders, the spirit of the sport, the environment or the organization.</p> <p>This includes going off course. The course is the currently established trail. The trail is dirt. The areas alongside the trail that are not the course have plants growing on them. Don't ride off the course over any plants.</p> <p>Chief of Race: Tom Spiegel</p>
	<p>AWARDS</p> <p>Awards at the finish immediately following the race on Sunday. Top 5 from each category need to be in attendance to receive their money/plaque or medal.</p>
	<p>EMERGENCY RESPONSE</p> <p>Medical staff will be available on course and at the start of each stage. Course Marshals are equipped with radios and are also a resource in the event of a medical emergency. The medical base is located in the Patrol Room on the first floor of Main Lodge.</p> <p>Nearest Medical Facility: Mammoth Hospital, 85 Sierra Park Road, Mammoth Lakes, CA 93546</p>
